#### Faculty Feedback 2023-24

Feedback was obtained from the faculty regarding the overall curriculum delivery and evaluation. The feedback collected was analyzed and interpreted. The following points were concluded from the feedback received.

- The staff are contented with the Clarity of Course Objectives (4.0/5)
- The availability of teaching materials and reference books was rated well by the staff (3.9/5)
- With clarity in the syllabus the staff's concern regarding whether the curriculum provides an
  opportunity for applied and advanced learning has improved compared to last academic year
  (3.8/5)
